LETTER RECOGNITION


Topic: Letter Tt

Objectives: By the end of this lesson you will be able to:

- 1. identify upper case and lower case Tt.
- 2. form the letter Tt.

Content

This is uppercase T. This is lowercase t. The letter Tt is a part of the alphabet. Here is how you form the letter Tt.



PHONICS

Topic: Initial Sound /t/

Objective: By the end of this lesson you will be able to:

- 1. say the initial /t/ sound.
- 2. identify words beginning with the letter

Content

The letter Tt makes the /t/ sound. To make the letter /t/ sound, press the tip of your tongue at the top of your mouth. Then separate your tongue and upper mouth by pushing a little air out to make the /t/ sound. Here are some words that begin with the letter Tt:

Topic: High Frequency Word- the

Content

"Over" means being in a higher position above something. "Under" means being in a lower position below something.

The bird is **under** the table.

Some things that are the shape of a diamond are:




