

LETTER RECOGNITION


Topic: Letter FF

Objectives: By the end of this lesson you will be able to:

- 1. identify upper case and lower case Ff.
- 2. form the letter Ff.

Content

This is uppercase F. This is lowercase f. The letter Ff is a part of the alphabet. Here is how you form the letter Ff.

We use the word "I" when talking about ourselves.

For example:

PHONICS


Topic: Initial Sound /f/

Objective: By the end of this lesson you will be able to:

- 1. say the initial /f/ sound.
- 2. identify words beginning with the letter

Content

The letter Ff makes the /fff/ sound. The initial F sound is made when the top teeth lightly touches the lower lips and air is gently pushed through the opening. Here are some words that begin with the letter Ff:

POSITIONAL WORDS

Topic: Top, Middle & Bottom

Objectives: By the end of this lesson you will be able to:

- 1. follow directions using positional vocabulary.
- 2. place objects at the "top" in the "middle" and at the "bottom".

Content

We use the terms "top", "middle" and "bottom" to talk about the position of people and objects. "Top" means at the highest point. "Bottom" means at the lowest point. "Middle" is in between the top and the bottom.



MATH CONCEPT

Topic: Big and Small

Objectives: By the end of this lesson you will be able to:

- 1. explain the terms big and small.
- 2. classify things that are big and small.

Content

We use terms big and small when comparing the size of objects. Here is a big and small ball.

Some things that are the shape of a triangle are:


pizza slice

small objects




Colour: Yellow

will be able to:


1. name external body parts.

We use our tongue to taste things and our teeth to chew our food.


We use our hands and fingers to feel and touch.
